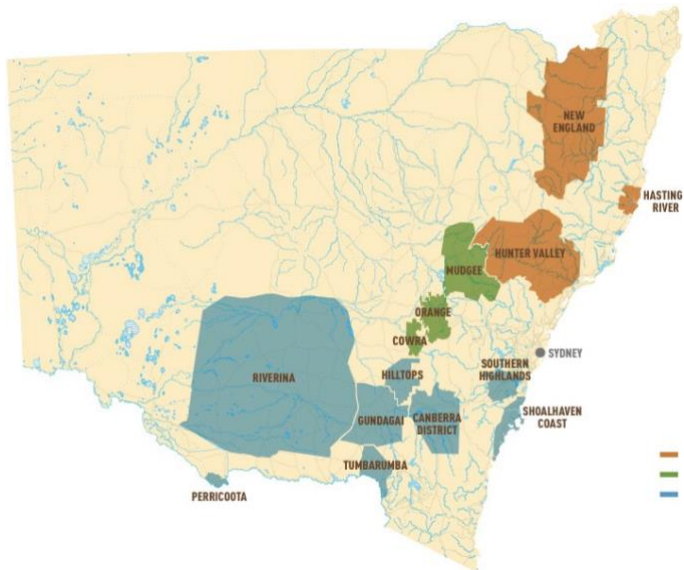

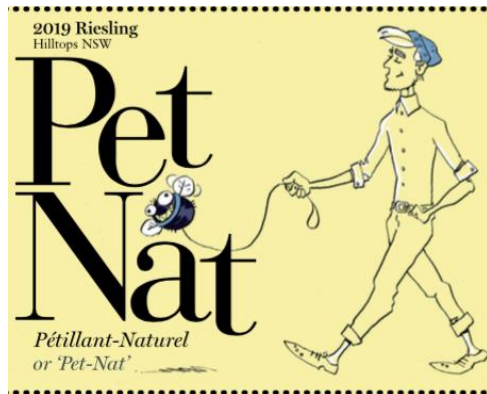

Urban Winery Sydney

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Pét-Nat is short for *Pétillant Naturel*, which is simply French for “Naturally Sparkling” – and that’s essentially what it is! This light and gently fizzy wine is an amazingly addictive alternative to Beer or Cider, and is currently all the rage in the natural wine making movement.

Our Pét-Nat is made from Riesling and comes from the Hilltops region of NSW. It is made by bottling the wine just before the end of fermentation, thus the ferment continues in the bottle making it lightly sparkling. This is known as Method Ancestral and is oldest known sparkling wine making method.

This soft and lightly sparkling wine displays delicate aromatic notes of honeysuckle, crushed apples, ginger and apricots, and on the palate the wine reminiscent of a good French cider. Wild, and vibrant with a very dry citrus finish although this can vary from bottle to bottle as each wine is unique. Have a glass, or bottle, Share with a friend or just by yourself this wine is meant to be drunk cold, young and in the sun.
